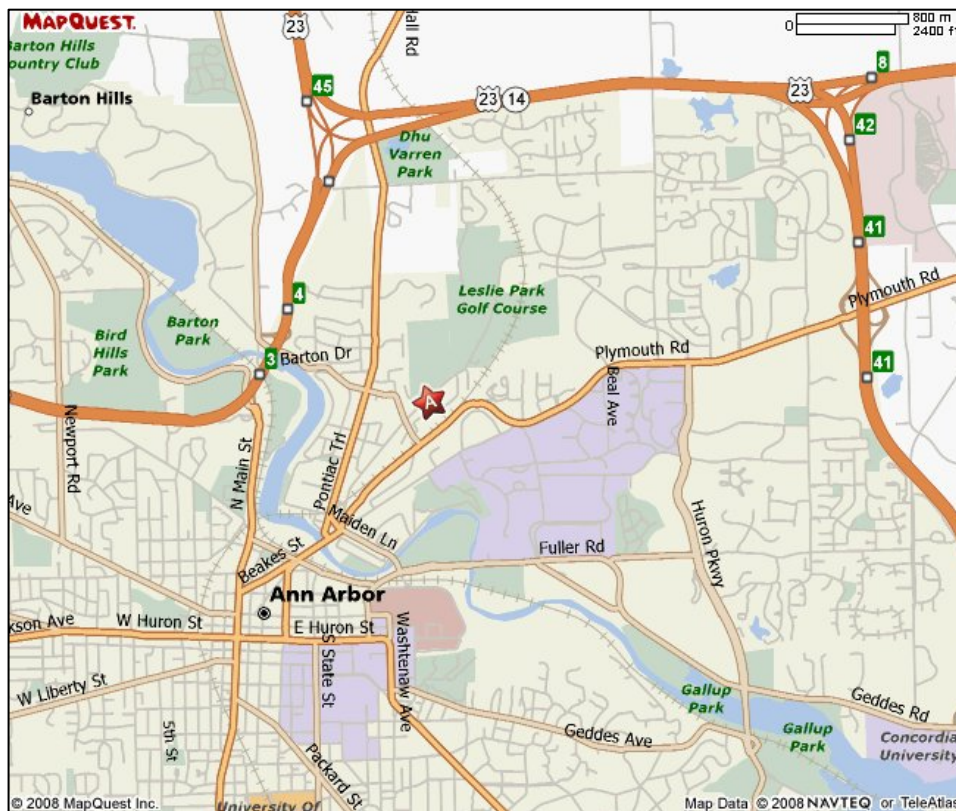
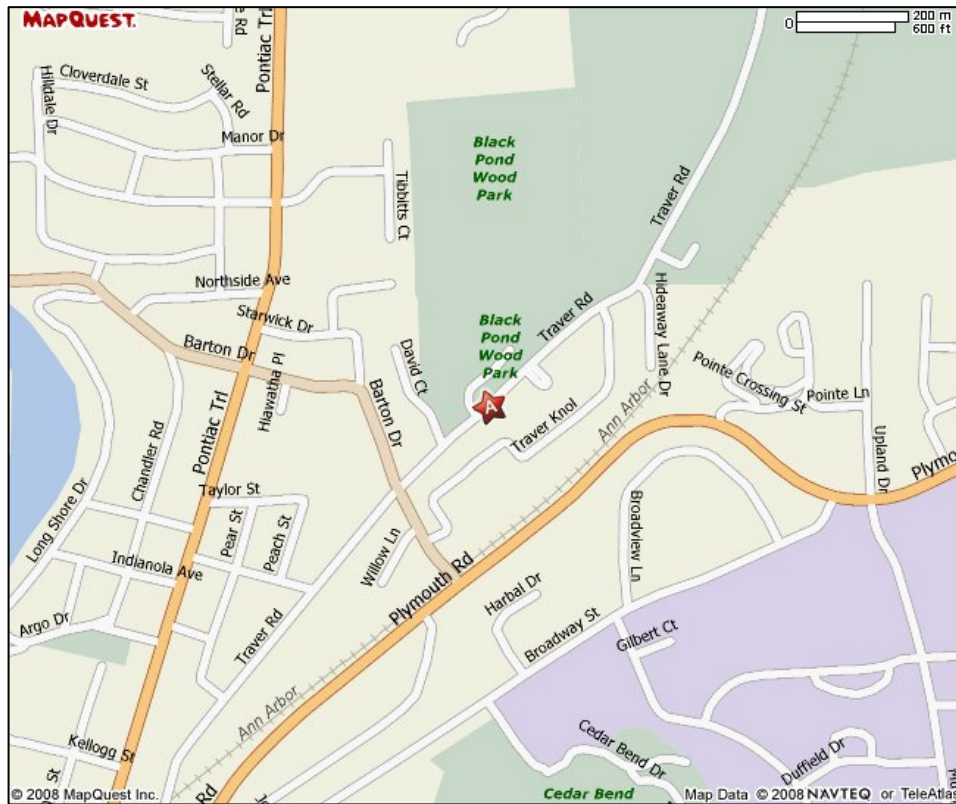

5. Task Force Updates

a. E-waste

- i. We have 4 more boxes of analog to digital transition.
- ii. Hoping to partner up with Channel 7's Green Team to have an electronics collection at a school.
- iii. There is concern about importance of being proactive in anticipation of the transition. Must get the word out about alternative/proper disposal methods.
- iv. In May for the first 2 County collections, cost of TV disposal was \$.11/lb, and now it is \$.50/lb.
