Milan City: Water drawn from three wells each between 80 and 100 feet is pumped to the city's water treatment plant where air is introduced to oxidize iron and then filtered to remove iron. The water is disinfected and stored in elevated storage tanks. Contact: (734) 439-1780

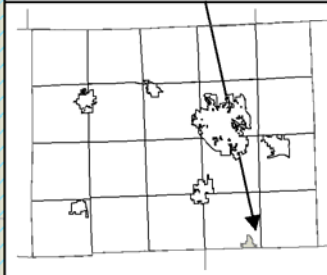
Milan City – Saline River



Milan City: Water Quality Indicators

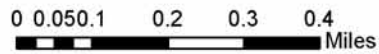
