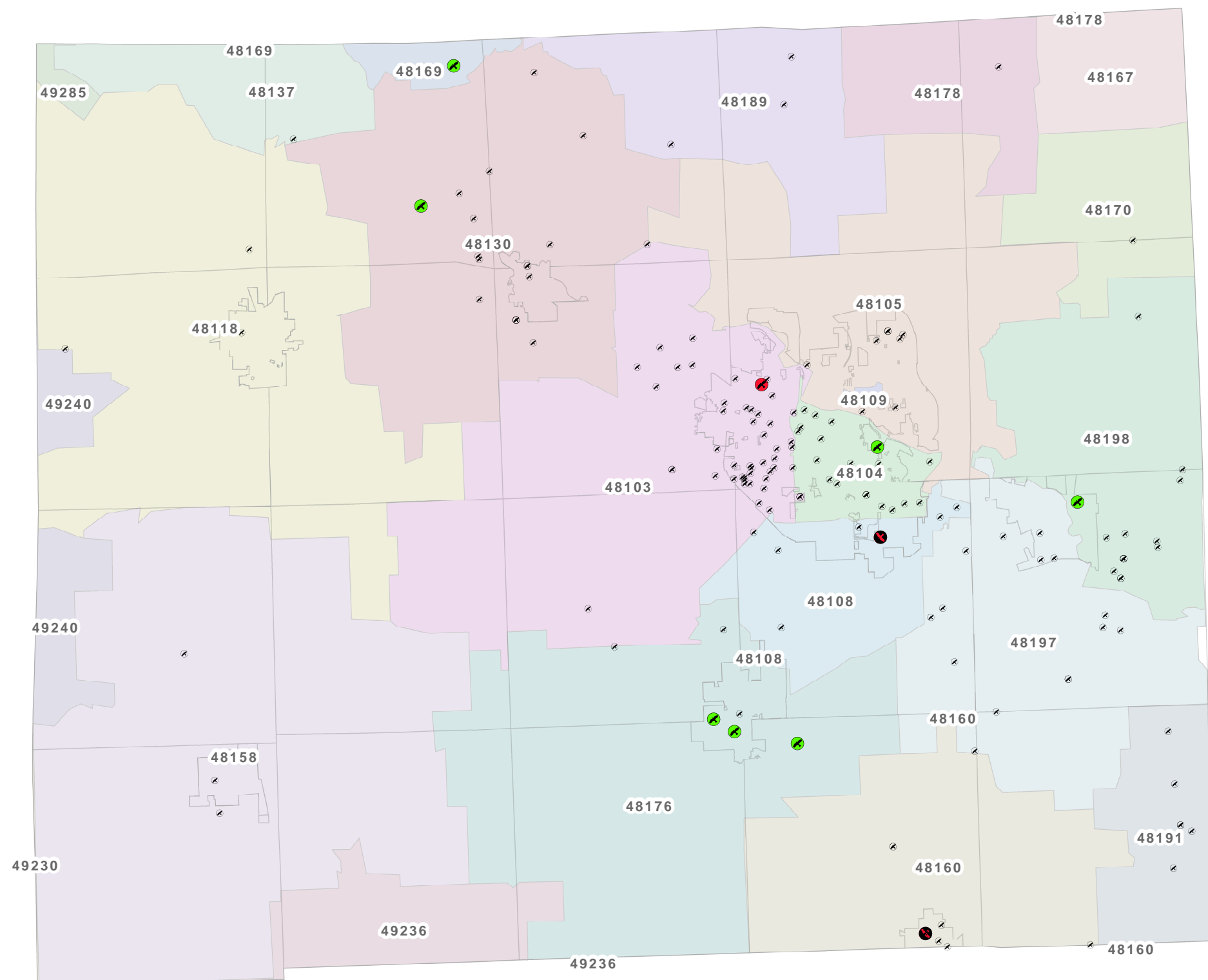





# - 2003 - Corvids\* Reported -- Washtenaw County (As of December 8, 2003)

Corvids (birds) die of many causes, and reporting levels may vary among townships and zip codes.
