

## Livestock & Dairy Committee Meeting – November 5, 2008

Secretary's report had the following amendment:

Member will pay a \$10.00 per animal if they do not go through the sale.

Motion made by Ginger B. and second by Bev O. motion carried to approve

Treasurer's report was read and approved.

### Old Business

- Youth Show Book Changes
  - Swine club herd will consist of 3 animals shown by a minimum of 2 members. Motion was made by Jean M. and second by Bev O. Motion was carried.
  - After much discussion Terri C. moved to approve a motion to try the banners for Sweepstakes only. Bev O. second. Motion was carried.
- Feeder Calf Class:
  - Feeder calves will be sold through the main large animal sale
  - Feeder calves will be shown before the champion drive
  - Exhibitor must determine if they are going to bring the calve back to show the next year as a beef animal prior to feeder show
  - After much discussion on housing of feeder calves a motion was made by Bev O. and second by Mary H. that feeder calves will be housed with the clubs beef, only one member present had opposition, motion carried
  - If retagging of your animal is required the member must contact the superintendent and leader immediately. The superintendent will contact the office to obtain tagging equipment and go with leader to member's farm to retag animal. Motion made by Jean M. and second by Bev O. motion carried
- Haul In of Animals
  - If you or your club have concerns with haul in please e-mail them to Jackie at the office
- There was an amendment to the issue of animals being out of order from the last meeting.
  - Only swine will be required to remain in order of sale bill. All other species will be placed at the end of the line up.

## New Business

- 2009 Superintendents
  - Superintendents are the same with the addition of Mark Summerville as assistant for sheep
  - Jackie will submit superintendents for approval to the Farm Council
  - Superintendent of species must be at load out
- Supervision of barns at night
  - There must be an adult present in each barn
  - May have kids with the adult

  - An increase of 10% over last years cost will be spent for up dating
- Sign for Feeder Calves
  - Cindy will check with Andy Luckhardt to see if he would be willing to make signs.
- PQA
  - Jackie M. will schedule dates for spring.
  - Still need volunteers to assist.
- Feed Pans
  - Information regarding the use of another members feed pans will be discouraged. This will be placed in the Youth Show Book.
- 2009 Judges
  - A motion was made to approve the list of judges as submitted by Terri C and second by Bev O. motion carried.
- There was discussion regarding the purchase of ear tags. Service Club normally picks up the cost. If they do not do this Livestock and Dairy would pay up to \$400.00 to purchase. Motion made by Jean Martin second by Bev O. motion carried.
