GENERAL INFORMATION: All decisions of the Judges and Horse Board are FINAL

Classes will be combined, canceled or divided at the discretion of the Horse Board.

The exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1, of the year they are exhibiting.

Checks returned for insufficient funds will be accessed an additional \$25.00 fee.

4-H Bulletin 1145 will govern all classes pertaining to equipment, tack, rules, etc. Chaps are optional in all Stock Seat classes.

Exhibitors will wear proper dress and horses will be in proper tack for all classes entered. Exhibitors will use the two-handed method of showing in all Fitting and Showing classes. **Sign-up for desired classes must be done TWO FULL CLASSES in advance. No refunds will be given.**

Ponies - Height - 56" and under.

Hunter Hack class - Horses and/or ponies will be shown at the walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop both ways of the ring and will be required to jump two (2) obstacles that will be set in the middle of the ring. Schooling jump decided by Horse Board.

SEI Approved headgear is required in all Hunter on the flat, all over the fences classes, in all gymkhana (games) classes, and during practice/warm-up for these classes.

All exhibitors under the age of 10 must wear a ASTM/SEI helmet at all times while riding. This includes western riders as well.

Dressage classes will run in Ring #2 beginning at 10:00 a.m. Only two dressage classes per horse-rider combination may be ridden. You must be signed up by 2:00 pm for your ride time. Dressage tests are USEF 2011 tests you can find online at www.usef.org.

Trail classes will begin running at 10:00 a.m. Check at Announcer's Stand for location.

Horses may ONLY be tied at horse trailers. They may NOT be tied in the wash rack areas.

Before you leave the grounds, we ask that you clean the area around your trailer.

All exhibitors are enrolled in High Point and that fee is \$5. High point is one rider/one horse. Each highpoint must have its own entry form. If you wish not to enroll for high point, you must sign the form in the appropriate box when you turn in your enrollment. Points for high point are assigned as follows, regardless of number of entries; 6 points for 1st, 5 points for 2nd, 4 points for 3rd, 3 points for 4th, 2 points for 5th, and 1 point for 6th. Counting the number of 1st placings, etc will break high point ties. While ribbons will be awarded through 8th place, only placings through 6th will count toward high point.

The following classes count towards High Point awards:

16 - 18 Horse: 1, 12, 13, 24, 30, 40, 45, 51, 77

13 - 15 Horse: 2, 12, 13, 25, 31, 41, 46, 52, 78

10 - 12 Horse: 3, 12, 13, 26, 32, 42, 47, 53, 79

13 - 18 Pony: 4, 12, 13, 27, 33, 43, 48, 54, 77 or 78

10 - 12 Pony: 5, 12, 13, 28, 34, 44, 49, 55, 79

13 - 18 Walk/Trot: 7, 14, 21, 80

9 - 12 Walk/Trot: 8, 15, 22, 81

16 - 18 Gymkhana: 59, 62, 65, 68

13 - 15 Gymkhana: 60, 63, 66, 69

10 - 12 Gymkhana: 61, 64, 67, 70

A Combined Training High Point will be awarded to the overall high score of Hunter Hack and Dressage (10-18). This is included in the registration fee. You can choose to opt out of this award and other High Point classes by signing in the appropriate space on the form.
