A **MANDATORY** pre-bid meeting and site visit to be attended by all General Contractors who will be submitting bids is scheduled for **Thursday, July 17, 2008 at 2:00pm**. The meeting will be held at Parker Mill County Park - Geddes Road. This meeting will consist of a review of the site and the contract documents.

The work consists of careful preparation for and construction of a pedestrian bridge over Fleming Creek, sidewalk and limestone fines trail, a boardwalk/swale crossing, a shelter/pavilion with "green roof", and site restoration of this sensitive natural area. Bidders should be aware that careful work is required for all activities on-site given the proximity of the creek, wetlands and trees to the limits of construction. Construction is to be completed NLT December 31, 2008.

Any organization contemplating bidding this project shall have been an established business entity for a five-year period prior to submission of the bid and shall have satisfactory evidence of at least three successful projects of this type.

A certified check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the base bid must accompany each bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory insurance in the amounts specified in the Insurance section. Requirements for Performance and Labor and Materials Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price are set forth in the Bonds section of the documents.
