Fees: All fees are due at the time of registration. No discounts for siblings. Fee includes Camp T-Shirt, park entry fees, and field trips. * \$10 Discount if annual pass holder.

Counselor-in-Training: We offer a CIT program for teens 12-15. Ask for more details.

Cancellations: All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to the Camp Director no later than 5pm on the Thursday prior to the enrolled session. Cancellations submitted by the deadline will be refunded, minus a \$25 cancellation fee per week, per child. No refunds will be issued for requests submitted after the deadline without a physician's note for illness or injury.

Transfers: All transfer requests must be submitted in writing to the Camp Director and will only be processed if space allows. After June 1, all transfers will incur a \$10 fee per week, per child. Registration transfers between locations (Independence Lake County Park, Meri Lou Murray Recreation Center, and Rolling

Hills County Park) will also incur a \$10 fee per week, per child. Transfers are not permitted after the enrolled session has begun.

Late Pick-Up Charges: Parents picking up Campers after 5:15pm are expected to pay \$1/minute for after-post-care supervision.
