MRPA Hoops Challenge

A basketball skills competition for boys and girls ages 8 to 15 will be held at the Meri Lou Murray Recreation Center in Ann Arbor on Sunday, February 3rd at 2:00 p.m. This individual competition offers participants 60 seconds to shoot and score from several locations on a half court with each spot assigned a different point value. Girls and boys with the highest score in each age bracket will advance to an area level competition in Saline on March 9th and eventually to the Palace of Auburn Hills on April 13th to compete for the Michigan Hoops Challenge Championship!

Separate divisions are offered for ages 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 and 14-15. Participants are not required to pre-register but will need to bring a copy of their birth certificate. Anyone playing for their middle school or high school team can compete in this competition without jeopardizing their eligibility. There is no charge to participate in this event. The Murray Recreation Center is located on the southwest corner of Washtenaw Avenue and Platt Road in Ann Arbor.
