Group Visit Rules

1. This is not a reservation. Groups are admitted on a first come, first serve basis.
2. The Group Leader will gather the whole group at the first available area on the sidewalk leading up to the admissions booth
3. The Group Leader will pay the admission fee, including chaperones and drivers, at the Water Park service gate near the admission booth (do not stand in line with the general public). Following payment, one of our staff will admit your group.
4. We require a minimum of 1:10 chaperone to child ratio. The Group Leader must assign chaperones to locations throughout the Water Park to properly supervise the group's children at all times.
5. We strongly suggest your group use a "Buddy System" to include:
 - a. pairing children up as "Buddies"
 - b. instructing "Buddies" to never leave their "Buddy" alone
 - c. "Buddies" must report to a chaperone at pre-determined times and location.
6. Read the following rules to your group:
 - a. No food or beverages are allowed in the water park. You are NOT allowed to bring your picnic lunch food items into the Water Park Concession area.
 - b. No coolers, large bags, large items of any kind are allowed. (space limitations)
 - c. NO GUM/CANDY is allowed in the Water Park.
 - d. Walk at all times. Running is unsafe and the main cause of injury at the water park.
 - e. Weak or non-swimmers must stay in the shallow end of the pools.
 - f. If you get lost or need help, go to the nearest lifeguard. Listen to and obey all lifeguard instructions – they are here to help you!! Read and follow all rule signs in the bathhouse, at the bottom and top of the waterslide stairs, and throughout the water park. They are for your safety.
 - g. Lockers cost \$.50/use.
 - h. Tubes are FREE of charge. Tubes may not leave the water and may not be held for future use.
 - i. A clock is located in the First Aid office window.
 - j. A drinking fountain is located on the bathhouse wall, near the First Aid office.
