Citizen and Local government representatives of CARD will provide an update on PALL's "*Comprehensive Proposal to Modify Cleanup Program*" submitted on May 4, 2009, to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). Included in this proposal is a further expansion of the Prohibition Zone established by the Court to prevent groundwater use and potential exposure to contaminated groundwater, and significant reductions in the active remediation activities (groundwater extraction and treatment).
