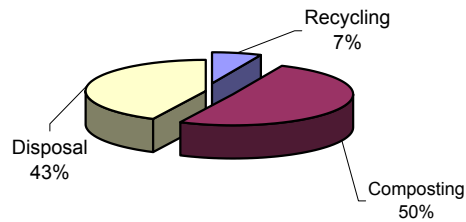

## Program Management

**Cost per household:** \$216 per year for solid waste, recycling and yard waste services. \$18 per month charged on water bill.

**Education:** Relies on county's information.

## Recommendations:

1. Work with neighboring communities to study a multi-community single hauler system or joint contracting group that would lead to better prices, services and incentives.
2. Incorporate waste volume control measures (such as set out limits and PAYT) to increase participation in diversion programs.
