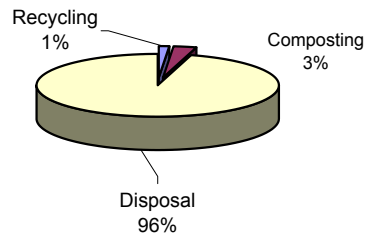

Program Management

Cost per household: Standard service with cart and recycling: \$180-264 per year. (Monroe's recycling cost is \$5 for 20 bags, Superior Sanitation's recycling cost is \$1 per bag, and Mr. Rubbish does not offer recycling.)

Recommendations:

- Implement a single hauler system (franchised hauler/preferred hauler) resulting in:
 - Expanded services for residents at lower costs
 - Community-based incentives such as roadside clean-up, special collection days and educational materials
 - Decreased truck traffic and wear on local roads
 - Hauler manages billing function
- Work with neighboring communities to study a multi-community single hauler system or joint contracting group that would lead to better prices, services and incentives.
- Incorporate waste volume control measures (such as set out limits and PAYT) to increase participation in diversion programs.
