**1. Call to order and Introductions (6:00PM).**

**4. Green Info Guide Updates**

- Jeff - Have been successfully distributed throughout library system.
- Jeff - State of Michigan really liked it.
- Jeff - MRC wanted to create guide in same format for the state. Met with Kerrin O'Brien regarding this. Idea to have companies listed on the GIG, coupled with idea to sell GIGs to make profit. Jeff will likely attend a future meeting to pursue this.

**5. Legislative Updates**

- Clean MI Initiative fund has been dropped. Not in the budget for 2009. No more state-funded cleanups will take place. Place article in the "In the News" section of website.

### **a. Pharmaceutical Take-Back**

- i. Jeff - Put out RFQs. \$0.55/lbs. Med Serve. Press release to be released next week. Trying to get as many pharmacies on board as possible
- ii. Jeff - Rebecca from the "Environment Report" on NPR to announce the program over radio. Barbara to edit video on proper medication take-back.
- iii. Michael David – buy domain name to increase frequency of visits. The domain name would link to main website. WCCSWM to help purchase domain name.
- iv. Group collectively agrees that \$50 should be allocated toward purchasing domain name. Still need to decide domain name.

### **b. Electronic Waste**

- i. CTN will give us many opportunities to advertise/talk about the issue for educating the public

## **7. Local Community Updates**

- Allison – Bookmarks handed out by UM OSEH at Green Fair contained high levels of lead. There is a recall
- Chris – New recycling truck in Ypsilanti City.
- Jeff – WWRA is doing \$2.4 million expansion in recovery facility. Going through county for funding. Want to expand outside the county. Purchasing \$900,000 compactor that does automated separator to increase efficiency.
- Chris – Charged a fuel surcharge in trash contract.
- Jeff – Very likely to hold Clean-Up Day at EMU in Fall. Details to be determined.
- Jeff – First two collections were approx. \$29K, 1,000 residents. \$7000 in donations. Budget was \$20,000. Only \$2000 over budget.
