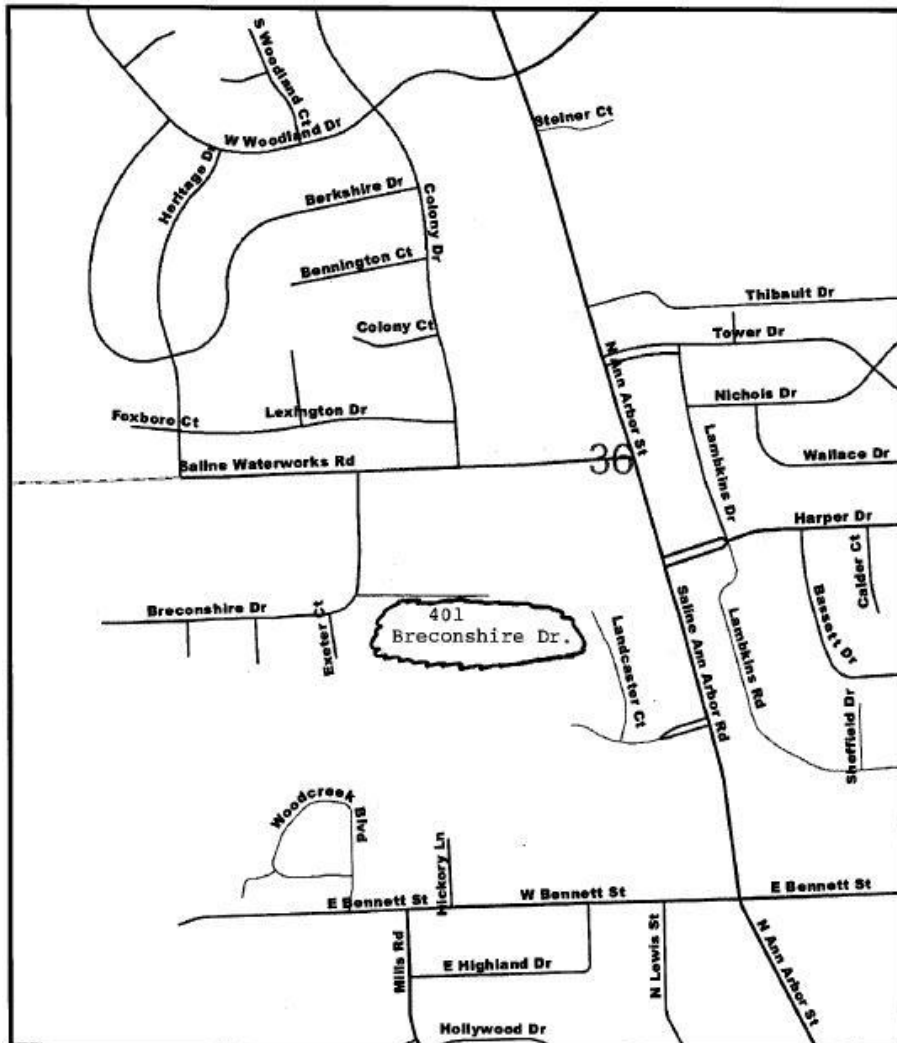
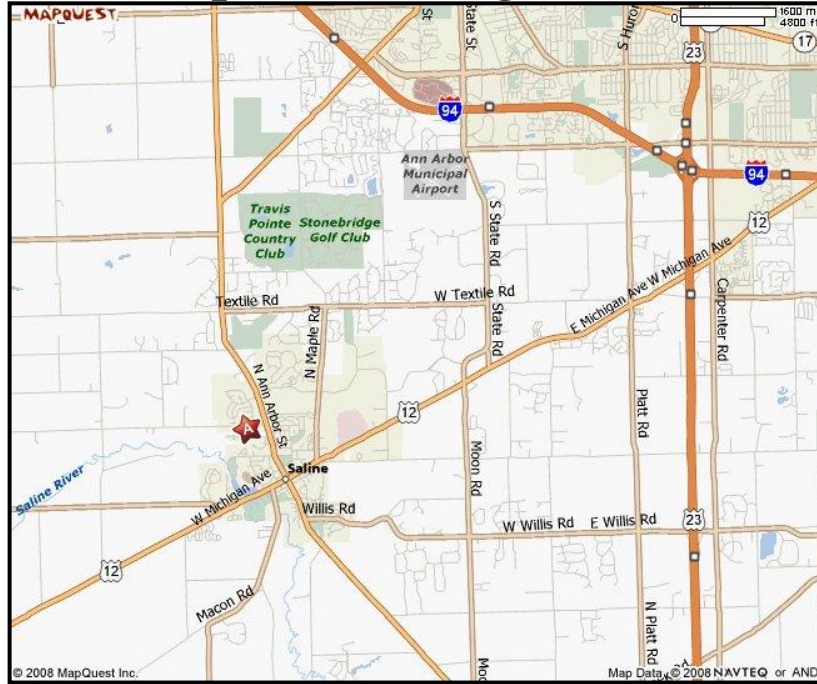

July 24th, 2008

1. Call to order and Introductions (5:45PM).

2. Approve agenda for July 24th, 2008.

4. Green Info Guide Updates

- Jeff - Have been successfully distributed throughout library system.
- Jeff - MRC would like to create a similar CD-ROM to distribute.

5. Legislative Updates

- No new updates.

6. Task Force Updates

a. Pharmaceutical Take-Back Program

- i. Jeff – No letter of understanding yet from St. Joe. Creating an insert of participating pharmacies. List of all veterinary offices, poison control, and other offices for mass mailing. Four pharmacies on board currently (still waiting on St. Joe).
- ii. Jeff – Bought domain name “dontflushdrugs.com” from GoDaddy.com for \$34. Use for pharmaceutical take-back program. Jeff was on radio show “Issues in the Environment” two weeks ago talking about the new program.
- iii. Nancy: Gaming systems can be taken at the Re-Use Center as well as all other working electronics such as TVs and computers.

7. Local Community Updates

- Nancy – A2 bought a large piece of land by the Materials Resource Recovery Facility for one million dollars to be used for DOS expansion. Extra space for compost expansion and the building of a new DOS. Will also include agricultural buffers.
 - i. Zero Waste at the Art Fair: there are 4 different art fairs, the Original or Ann Arbor Street Art Fair was given a grant to reach zero waste in the next two years. This year, they had many recycling posts for containers, and paper, and next year they'll try to collect food waste as well. Difficult due to vendors and the porous nature of the event. The city of Ann Arbor has developed a zero waste agenda for the coming years.
- Nancy – City of A2 has given a quarter of a million dollars for solid waste transportation for next year.
- Jeff – Bottle deposit law meeting to be held at Washtenaw Community College meeting regarding bottle deposit expansion. Consortium dollars to go towards members attending the one-day conference. Held the 4th or 5th of Nov.
- Dan – Shrink-wrap Recycling Program beginning this fall. Will be collection points throughout the county and Mondo Polymers will swing through on a seasonal basis to make pick-ups. Prefer the shrink-wrap to be bailed for pick-up. Based off of and receiving support from the Sea Grant national program for shrink-wrap recycling.
- Oct. 3rd decision makers meeting for Washtenaw County.
- “Green Business” seminar Friday, Aug. 1st.
- Jeff – Green Schools program: link on recycle.ewashtenaw.org site to Green School site for new school application.
- Treasury update: WCCSWM balance is over \$14,000. Possibly use some money towards scholarship for bottle deposit expansion meeting.
