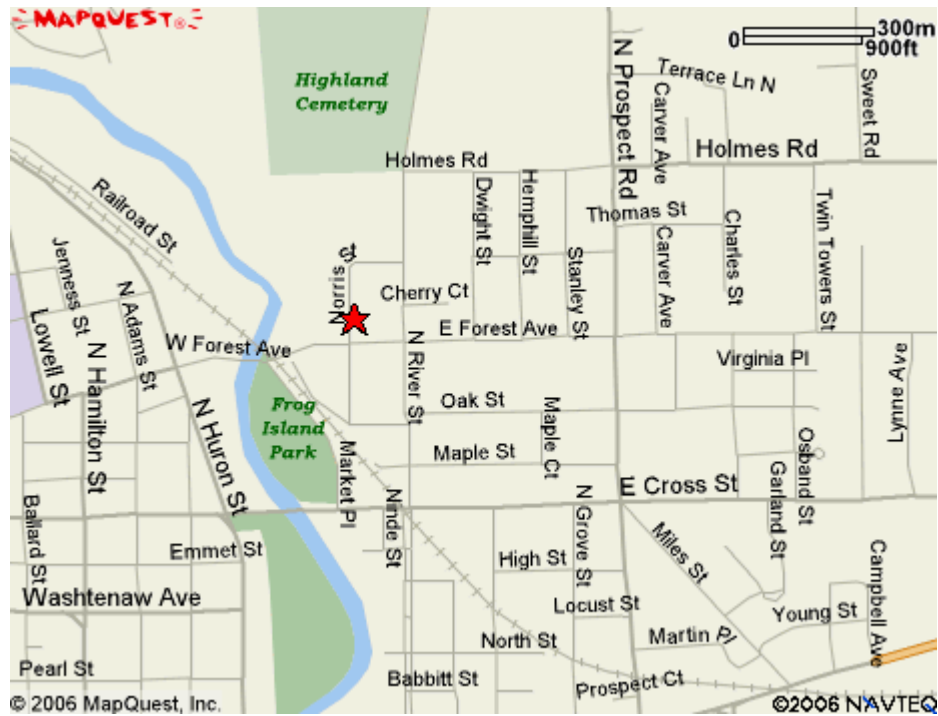

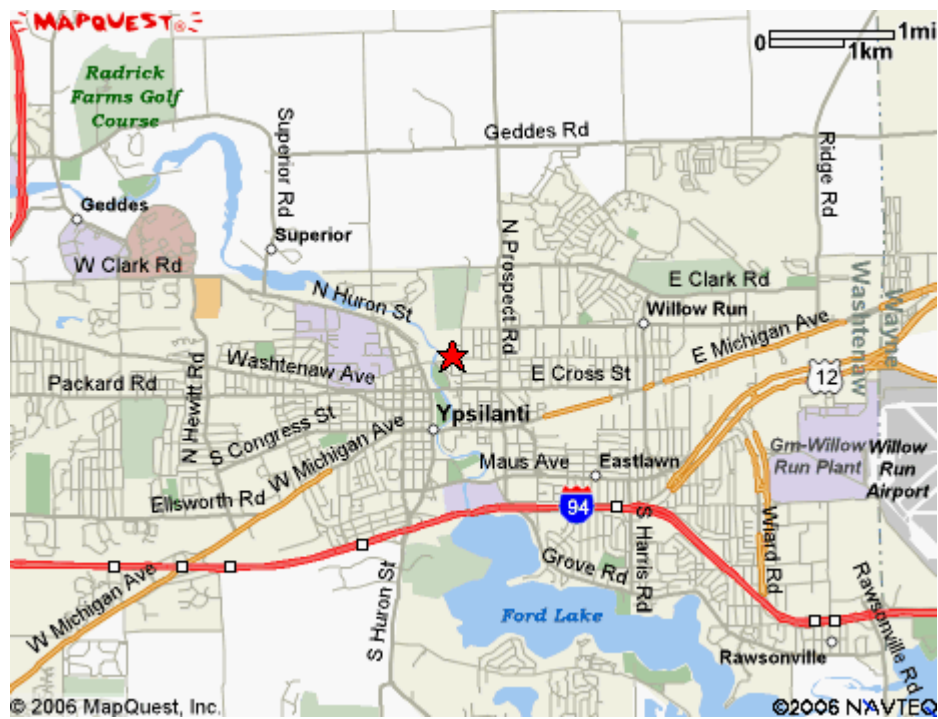

#### **1. Simmons Called Meeting to Order**

#### **2. Agenda for June 29<sup>th</sup> was approved as printed.**

#### **3. Minutes from May 25<sup>th</sup> were approved as corrected**

- Correction: In item #4 the motion was unanimously approved instead of seconded.

#### **4. Discussion of Alternative Energy Bus Tour**

- Sean Reed, the executive director of the Clean Energy Coalition and program manager of the Ann Arbor Area Clean Cities Program, whose mission is to reduce the US dependence on foreign oil through alternative energy sources, spoke with the group about his work and the possibility of having an alternative energy bus tour this fall, possibly in November. Reed has received a grant through the State Energy Office and he may use some of the money towards a 2-day conference and have the second day be a bus tour. Krcmarik mentioned the America Recycles Day celebration the County Waste Knot Program sponsors in mid-Nov. at Leopold Bros. and possible partnerships through that, involving WK partners.

Reed organized a successful bus tour in April centered around the grand opening of two biodiesel pumps at the Meijer store in Ann Arbor. He is thinking of having two kinds of bus tours this fall, one with a green building theme and the other with a transportation theme. He would like to know who is interested in helping with planning, marketing and attending the bus tours. Krcmarik mentioned that the County could help with promotion.

Reed has also received a \$200,000 highway grant to develop biodiesel and ethanol resources in the area. He is looking for fueling stations that are interested in putting in alternative fuel pumps, so please contact him if you know of a fueling station owner

Interesting information: AATA will begin using 5% biodiesel (B5) in its bus fleet this fall because Detroit Diesel allows that percentage of biodiesel to be used in its engines. Therefore AATA will not be jeopardizing its warranties by using B5.

#### 5. Green Info Guide Update:

- Simmons received copies of the GIG, as did Chapman. Moody, Krcmarik and Smither are working out a way to get the GIG online and will update the group as to its progress.

#### 6. Community Updates:

- Washtenaw County – Moody debriefed the group on the success of the Augusta Twp clean-up day on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. 457 cars came through, lots of e-waste, hazardous waste, and Freon recovery was done. Six gondolas of trash were collected, and over 1500 scrap tires. The County is unsure of financial resources to be able to host another clean-up day in the fall, so the next ones may be in the spring/fall of '07. However there may be a hazardous household waste/ewaste clean-up this year in Pittsfield Twp, partially sponsored by Best Buy, who will donate \$2500.
