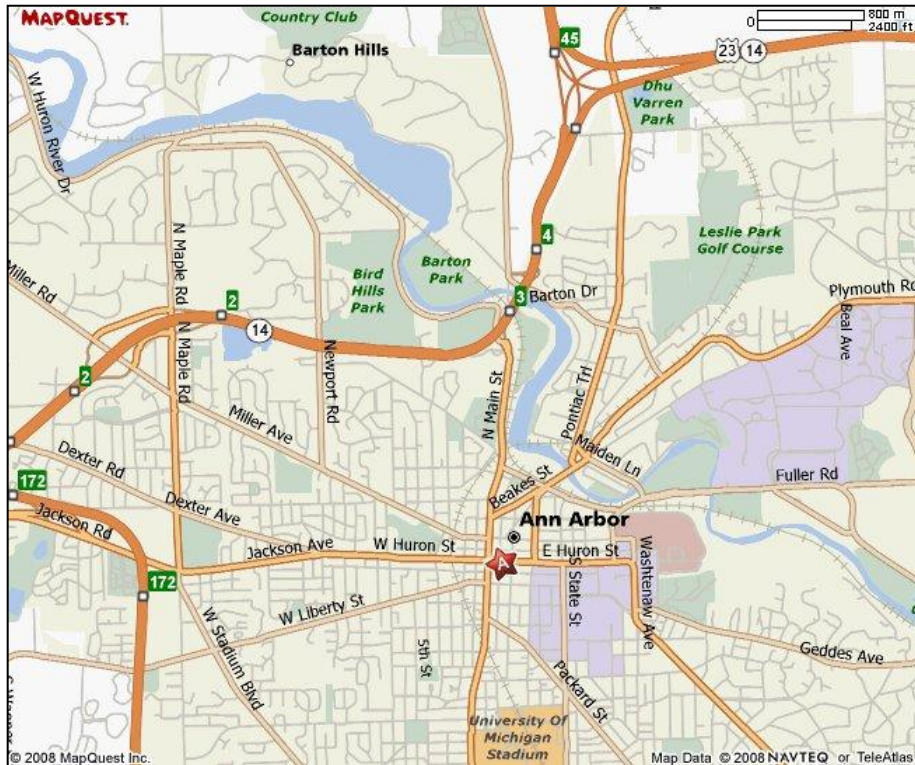
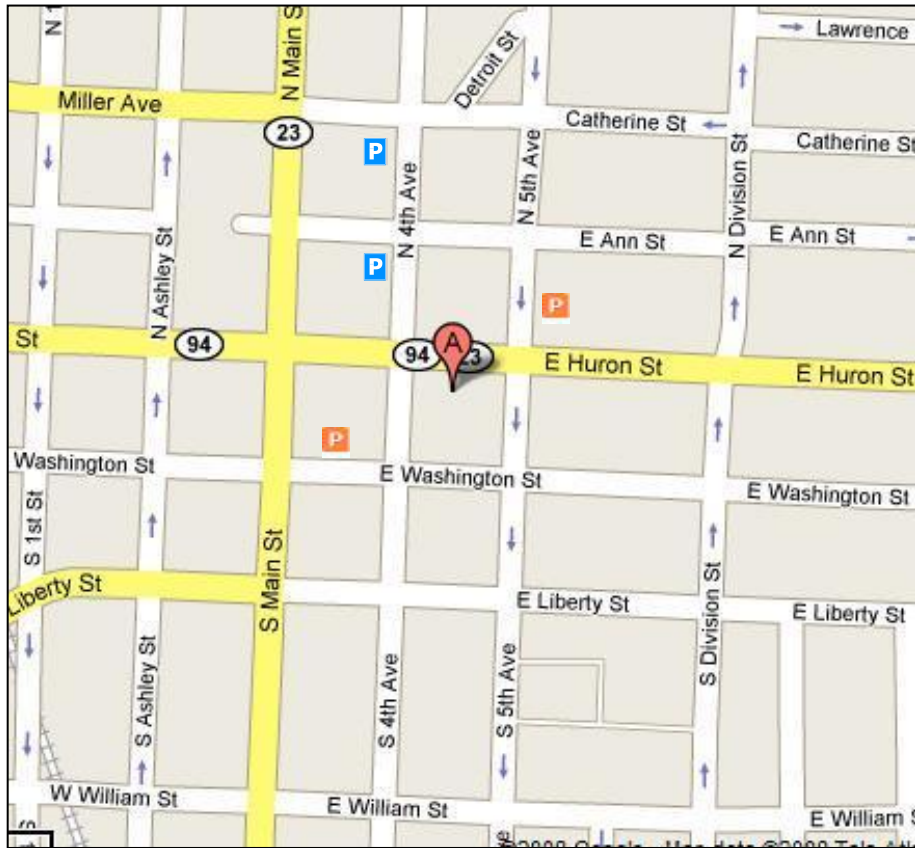

2. Approve Agenda for Sept 25th, 2008.

- a. Approved as Printed.

3. Approve Minutes from August 28th, 2008.

- a. Correction: 2500 GIGs were ordered, and not 25,000.
- b. Otherwise, approved as printed.

4. Task Force Updates

- a. E-Waste
 - i. Special Collection at EMU Nov 1. Focusing on TV disposal.
 - ii. Ypsi Township and EMU are all partnering up to support the clean up.
 - iii. EMU will provide workers, including some who will do surveys at gate.
 - iv. Price of TVs used to be \$.11/lb has risen to \$.50/lb. Huge jump.
 - v. Idea to strip excess weight of metals, etc from TVs to help reduce price.

- b. Pharmaceutical Take-Back
 - i. All Dexter pharmacies and Maple Village, Bailes will be receiving containers with locks.
 - ii. All pharmacies are listed on the website, www.dontflushdrugs.com, with maps and contact information.
 - iii. Busch's has approached us and is interested in participating. Expect to get more calls and interested pharmacies as publicity grows.
 - iv. Trying to get a feature radio show on NPR and also article in AA news publicizing the program.
 - v. Some pharmacies' bins are already filled. Some pharmacies aren't advertising. Level of participation varies among pharmacies.
 - vi. Mailing a pamphlet to send to all vet offices, hospitals, police offices, psychologist offices to advertise for the program. Around 400 total to be mailed out.
 - vii. At next meeting, bring pamphlets for people to pass out.
 - viii. So far, not going the "doctors without borders" route. The meds are going straight to incineration in Alabama with Enserve.
- c. Shrink Wrap
 - i. Dan Moody- Met with Ron Wesel from Mondo Polymers.
 - ii. Klave's and Mac's Marinas are on board for Shrink Wrap Recycling.
 - iii. Accept #2s and #4s.
 - iv. Mondo will purchase baled Shrink wrap, pick up un-baled for free.

5. Local Community Updates

- a. Dan - County Clean-Up Day November 1st, 9am-4pm.
- b. George – Green Remodeled house in Ann Arbor. The first LEED Platinum Addition/Remodel in the Great Lakes Region, and the 5th in the nation.
- c. Jeff – MRC having conference on Nov. 5th. Is Consortium interested in sponsoring people to attend conference? 4-6 people would be \$200-\$300.

Afterward the annual ARD celebration would take place at Arbor Brewing Company.
