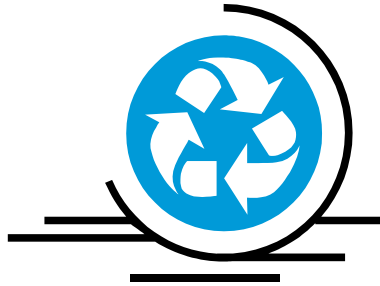

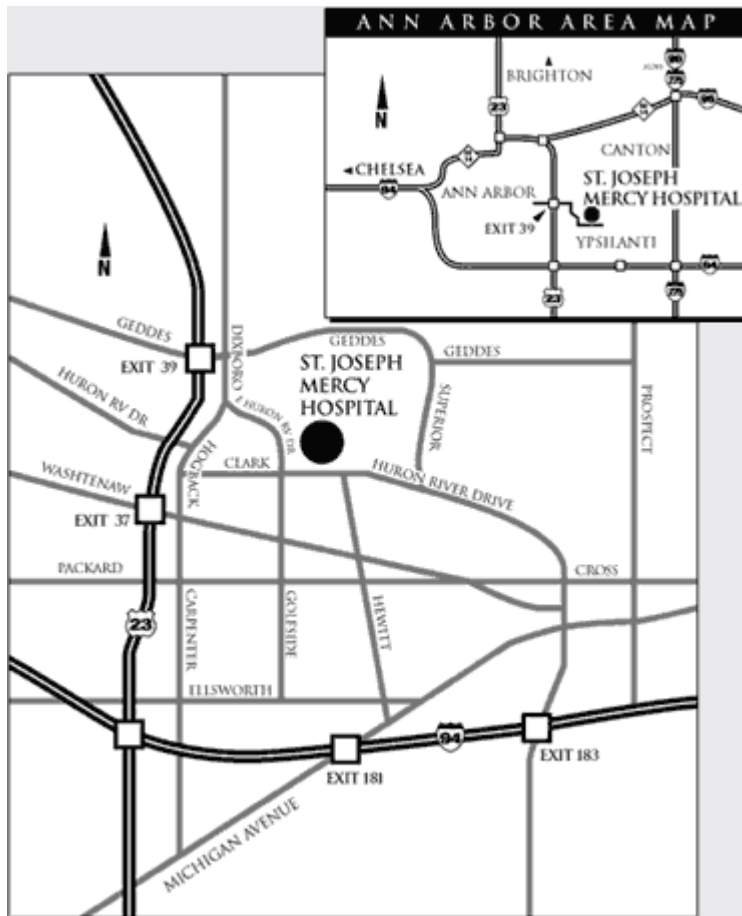
### Directions to Room EC #5

Attendees should go to the parking lot "P" off of Elliott Dr. on the SJMH campus in front of the 5305 Administrative Services Building. Enter the building through the front door, take the elevator to the second floor, leave the elevator and turn left and pass into the Education Center Hallway, take the first turn left into the classroom area and go to room EC# 5.

### **Directions to St. Joseph Mercy Hospital main campus**

#### **To SJMH from the southeast (Detroit, Southfield Freeway, Airport)**

Take I-94 West to Exit 181-B (Michigan Avenue). The right-curving exit will put you on Michigan Ave. Get into the left lane and turn LEFT (north) at the first traffic light at Hewitt. Stay on Hewitt for about 2.5 miles, crossing Ellsworth, Congress, Packard and then Washtenaw Ave. Continue straight on Hewitt. After you pass the EMU Stadium on your right, you'll cross Huron River Drive, as you enter the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital campus.

#### **To SJMH from the southwest (Jackson)**

Take I-94 East to Exit 180-B and get on US 23 North (toward Flint). Take this to Exit 39 (Geddes Road). Turn RIGHT (east) onto Geddes at the traffic light. Stay in the right lane on Geddes and

turn RIGHT (south) onto Dixboro Road, at the traffic light. Cross the railroad tracks and turn LEFT (east) onto Huron River Drive at the traffic light. You'll pass Washtenaw Community College on the right. Get into the left lane, and turn LEFT into the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital campus.

Alternative Directions to SJMH during Dixboro construction:

Instead of getting off at Exit 39 (Geddes Road), take Exit 37A (Washtenaw Avenue East) going towards Ypsilanti. Turn RIGHT at the end of the exit ramp and continue down Washtenaw to Golfside. Turn LEFT and continue down Golfside pass Clark Road until it turns into Huron River Drive. The hospital campus will be on the right hand side.

#### **To SJMH from the northeast (Plymouth, Northville, Livonia)**

Take I-275 South, to M-14 West toward Ann Arbor. Take M-14 West (14.4 miles) to US 23 South. Stay on US 23 South for about 3 miles and get off at Exit 39 (Geddes Road). Turn LEFT (east) onto Geddes at the traffic light. Stay in the right lane on Geddes and turn RIGHT (south) onto Dixboro Road, at the traffic light. Cross the railroad tracks and turn LEFT (east) onto Huron River Drive at the traffic light. You'll pass Washtenaw Community College on the right. Get into the left lane, and turn LEFT into the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital campus.

Alternative Directions to SJMH during Dixboro construction:

Instead of getting off at Exit 39 (Geddes Road), continue down US 23 and take Exit 37A (Washtenaw Avenue East) going towards Ypsilanti. Merge onto Washtenaw and continue down Washtenaw to Golfside. Turn LEFT and continue down Golfside pass Clark Road until it turns into Huron River Drive. The hospital campus will be on the right hand side.

#### **To SJMH from the northwest (Brighton, Flint, Pinckney)**

Take US 23 South to Exit 39 (Geddes Road). Turn LEFT (east) onto Geddes at the traffic light. Stay in the right lane on Geddes and turn RIGHT (south) onto Dixboro Road, at the traffic light. Cross the railroad tracks, and turn LEFT (east) onto Huron River Drive at the traffic light. You'll pass Washtenaw Community College on the right. Get into the left lane, and turn LEFT into the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital campus.

Alternative Directions to SJMH during Dixboro construction:

Instead of getting off at Exit 39 (Geddes Road), continue down US 23 and take Exit 37A (Washtenaw Avenue East) going towards Ypsilanti. Merge onto Washtenaw and continue down Washtenaw to Golfside. Turn LEFT and continue down Golfside pass Clark Road until it turns into Huron River Drive. The hospital campus will be on the right hand side.

#### **To SJMH from the south (Saline, Toledo)**

Take US 23 North to Exit 39 (Geddes Road). Turn RIGHT (east) onto Geddes at the traffic light. Stay in the right lane on Geddes and turn RIGHT (south) onto Dixboro Road, at the traffic light. Cross the railroad tracks, and turn LEFT (east) onto Huron River Drive at the traffic light. You'll pass Washtenaw Community College on the right. Get into the left lane, and turn LEFT into the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital campus.

Alternative Directions to SJMH during Dixboro construction:

Instead of getting off at Exit 39 (Geddes Road), take Exit 37A (Washtenaw Avenue East) going towards Ypsilanti. Turn RIGHT at the end of the exit ramp and continue down Washtenaw to Golfside. Turn LEFT and continue down Golfside pass Clark Road until it turns into Huron River Drive. The hospital campus will be on the right hand side.

1. Simmons Called Meeting to Order at 5:35
2. Approval of Agenda for August 25.
3. Approval of Minutes from July 28.
  - Correction made that under Local Updates, Mike Ogozaly represents FCI Milan and not City of Milan.
  - Also in the City of Ypsilanti Local Update The U of M bus is running on B20, it was not converted.
  - Minutes approved as corrected
4. Best Practices Update
  - Krcmarik asked Debra Power from Moore Power Marketing the Consortium's questions regarding the Best Practices CD's: Yes, we can make yearly updates for minimal cost, the CD's will work on IBM and MAC computers- you just need FLASH software, which most computers have or can download for free.
  - BenDor stressed importance of getting information on a website so twps can download and put it on their own CD's- whether it is the County website or WCCSWM's own website because County has specific rules for website layout and design.
  - One aspect we could consider is having it include a search engine with maps, so residents put in their address and get a list of where their services are located.
  - Stefani talked of how it would replace the handouts he gives to new residents moving to his area as well as be useful at the twp offices and libraries.
  - BenDor made a motion to spend up to \$1,000 with Moore Power Marketing to get a draft with a few steps included so we get the project going.
  - Stefani stressed that he would like to see a proposal so things are in writing and we understand the scope and expectation of work. Jeff agreed he would like to see a contract from her.
  - The motion to spend \$1,000 towards the project was tabled till next meeting
  - It was decided that Debra Power would be invited to attend next month's meeting to answer questions

5. State and Legislative Update

- **Solid Waste Surcharge Update:** Simmons discussed how Alma Smith wants to push the democratic solid waste disposal surcharge issue. Right now it is buried for this session

6. Local Community Updates

- Washtenaw County: Krcmarik reported that the **Clean-up Day** at the Calvary Bible Church was a success. There were lots of great volunteers, the sheriff and the church supplied workers as well. The County will recognize volunteers at the ARD event at Leopold Brothers in November. Sept. 24<sup>th</sup> is the last Clean-up Day of the year at the Saline Farm Council Grounds. Darcy agreed to put the flyer for the Clean-up Day on the website. Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> is the United Way Day of Caring **Home Product Pick-up for Senior Citizens**. There are 4 pick-up trucks scheduled to go out to pick up home toxic products for home-bound residents and the County is accepting registration until Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>. Finally, in April there will be a **conference on restaurant waste reduction techniques**. Right now Seva Restaurant, Tracy Artley, Michelle Binoni and others are involved. DEQ will be promoting it, the cost will be \$50 per person, and Save the Date cards will be coming soon.
