Acceptable items:

Stuffed chair: \$10/ea. Mattress and Box Spring: \$12/ea.
Couch: \$15/ea. Carpet rolls (10' roll): \$12/ea
Burning Barrels: \$5/ea Building Demolition: \$25/cubic yard
Appliances with freon removed: \$25/ea.
Household Trash: \$2.50 per 30 gallon trash bag and \$25 for pick-up load
Yard waste can be added to the city compost pile free of charge

Unacceptable items:

Liquid or hazardous waste, radioactive, volatile, or explosive material,
railroad ties or fence, or lead acid batteries.
