

HIP Implementation Team Meeting Minutes – 12/14/11

1. Announcements/Updates

- HIP website survey data status: Laura and Adreanne will be meeting with Washtenaw County IT to finalize details and get rid of the last bugs. There has been added complexity to this project due to integrating 2 waves of survey data. Goal is to have the site live by the January 17th CHC meeting. Request from Els to have the site compatible with the “text aloud” system.
- Washtenaw HC Initiative: need an update from Dr. Reeves since Adreanne is no longer on the Steering Committee
- Proposal to adopt HIP framework statewide: Shared letter from Director Olga Dazzo; HIP proposal is supported by Meghan Swain at MALPH and has presented it to Jean Chabut and Nick Lyon; MALPH best practice submission is in process.
- Adreanne has been looking at injury code data related to suicide attempts. There are about 2 attempts per day, with about 50% under the age of 25 years. She has presented the data to the Washtenaw Alive coalition.
- Laura shared that there has been an increase in Hepatitis C infections in young people under the age of 30 years. WCPH is looking further into the issue as many of the infections are due to IV drug use.
- Fran went to a national meeting for Partners for a Healthier America which targets the 9 million kids participating in YMCA activities. She met Michelle Obama as this is part of the Let’s Move initiative.
- Project Healthy Schools in Willow Run has received a Beard Foundation Grant.
- Project Healthy Schools is starting their program in the Lincoln schools with the 6th graders. RAHS will also be starting a clinic in Lincoln.
- The Ypsi Farm to School group is talking about possibly expanding to Willow Run and Lincoln schools in the future once they get their Farm to School project on firm footing throughout this school year.

2. **Special presentation:** Els N. gave a very interesting presentation on how to frame disability in a different way: “Health, chronic conditions and disability ... a conceptual shift”. Good discussion afterwards. Els suggests looking at the following WHO World Report on disability:
