Introductions and Announcements

- Kathy Leonard is retiring from Michigan Visiting Nurses and from HIP after starting with HIP as far back as 2000. HIP will miss her dedication and commitment and many years of leadership and guidance she has offered!
- WCPH has a new Medical Director. Her name is Monique Reeves and she has ten years of experience as an ER physician as well as an MPH. Her energy and enthusiasm is contagious and will be a wonderful asset to the county.
- Hope Clinic just opened its new facility on Harriet. It's a great location, just across from Perry Elementary and allows for more services offered in one location.
- Jean attended the mid-Atlantic Summit for "Let's Move". There really is no mid-western "Let's Move" region and she is considering playing a key role in initiating one. *She will keep us posted.*
- Tyler Norris was a keynote presenter at the Healthy Communities conference sponsored by MDCH a few weeks ago. He had a message of the need to increase the "dose" of an individual's "exposure" to healthy choices and messages and that behavior will not change until the frequency and intensity of doses reaches a certain amount (tipping point). *Keven will email his slides to Implementation Team.*
- Washtenaw Health Initiative – Ruth and Adreanne both participate. Recommendations are in development and the group plans to continue on. They will keep us posted as recommendations are selected. They will launch a website in early July. Keven will send URL on listserv. Adreanne suggested having a CHC meeting on the initiative inviting Bob Guenzel. Members expressed interest in this and *Adreanne will continue to explore with WHI leadership.*
- WCPH in partnership with UM recently submitted an application to both RWJF and Blue Cross Blue Shield to collaborate on a demonstration project linking community with clinical health interventions around diabetes.
- Washtenaw Community College might be an organization for HIP to proactively invite and encourage to become a HIP partner. Tricia Piechowski from MICHHR may be connected with them and would be a good contact. *Keven will follow up with Tricia first to identify a contact.*

1. Increase Understanding and Awareness of Data

- **2010 HIP Survey status** – Data are being reviewed by Adreanne, Laura, Andy (intern). The July 13 data retreat may be postponed because there may not be enough time to prepare for the event depending on how their data review goes. Keven will notify participants and choose a new date if necessary.

- **Data retreat agenda** – We reviewed the proposed agenda and thought it sounded appropriate. Kathy suggested sending out the meeting agenda to folks who have not yet rsvp'ed since the agenda items might catch their attention. *Keven will send the agenda out prior to the retreat and will also include with Implementation Team minutes.*

2. Develop Specific Activities to Work on Collaboratively

- **Review/discuss proposed Ideas from HIP Workplan** - The above is a HIP workplan recommendation from the retreat. Discussion revolved around better understanding what the statement actually means. Its "meaning" included: 1) HIP should function as a 'clearinghouse' to help organizations identify other organizations interested in partnering on a specific health topic or issue. HIP needs to develop a method or way to help organizations connect on those issues; 2) Partners collaboratively identify an issue, set goals, assign tasks, divide up the work, and work towards achieving the goals. An example would be selecting HKHM and advocating for policies it selected. *Keven said HIP Internal Team will work to clarify the specifics of what this means and will communicate with both Implementation and Coordinating since it is a HIP workplan goal.*

3. Grow Partnerships Across Sectors and Disciplines

- **Success Story** - Keven shared the SJMHS Success Story and encouraged others to submit an idea as well as share. UM is going to submit one soon. Kathy suggested posting to AA.com. *Keven will look into this with Sharon Sheldon.*

We discussed having another CHC on this topic or even a separate informal meeting/gathering for those interested in the topic to continue sharing.
