Photovoice provides a way for youth in the community to explore and communicate their perceptions and experiences related to underage drinking.

Goals of Youth Photovoice:

- To empower youth to become actively involved with community change efforts around underage drinking in Pinckney.
- To create dialogue on underage drinking in Pinckney.

What is Youth Photovoice?

- Five youth from Pinckney High School worked on the project.
- The youth took pictures on aspects of community life that they feel influence youth drinking and related traffic crashes. Then discussed why they took the pictures, ultimately selecting 3-4 to be displayed with narratives at an exhibit at the Hamburg Township Library on January 27, 2009.
- To continue the dialogue on underage drinking the photos will be featured at local businesses and establishments around Pinckney and on-line. A collection of the photos are also available for meetings or events upon request.
