## On the 2005 HIP Survey!

### **What is the HIP Survey?**

- An anonymous telephone survey of 2,000 randomly selected Washtenaw County residents to measure the health of the community

### **When will the survey happen?**

- Phone calls will be made between October and December 2005
- Results will be available in April 2006

### **How will the call show up on caller id?**

- Depending on your telephone and caller ID providers, the identification on caller ID may be "Michigan State University" or "out of area/private caller/anonymous/unavailable"

### **How do survey results benefit residents?**

- Survey data helps direct your tax dollars to areas of greatest need for health improvement such as:
  - ~ Chelsea/Manchester/Dexter walking program
  - ~ Community gardening programs in Ypsilanti
  - ~ School-based health services for children in Ann Arbor
  - ~ Prescription coverage by the Washtenaw County Health Plan
  - ~ Substance abuse prevention media campaign in Milan middle schools
  - ~ Chronic disease prevention projects such as the *Pick Up the Pace*, *Saline!* community walks & pedometer promotion

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
