Update on H1N1 Vaccination Clinics for First Responders and Health Care Workers

- Washtenaw County Public Health will hold three H1N1 vaccination clinics next week for first responders and **non-hospital** health care workers who provide direct patient care. Area hospitals have received limited allotments of H1N1 vaccine to begin vaccinating their priority staff. Hospital employees should contact the appropriate individuals or departments within their system for information.
- These clinics are open to individuals who live or work in Washtenaw County.
- Vaccine is free but eligible individuals will need to show a work identification badge.
- Both the nasal spray (FluMist) and flu shot formulation are available in limited quantities; however, the **flu shot supply is currently very limited**. Vaccines will be given on a first come, first served basis.
