H1N1 Vaccine Clinics for First Responders and Health Care Workers

- Washtenaw County Public Health will hold three H1N1 vaccine clinics next week for first responders and health care workers who provide direct patient care.
- These clinics are open to individuals who live or work in Washtenaw County.
- Vaccine is free but individuals will need to show a work identification badge.
- Both the nasal spray (FluMist) and flu shot formulation are available; however, the flu shot supply is currently limited.
