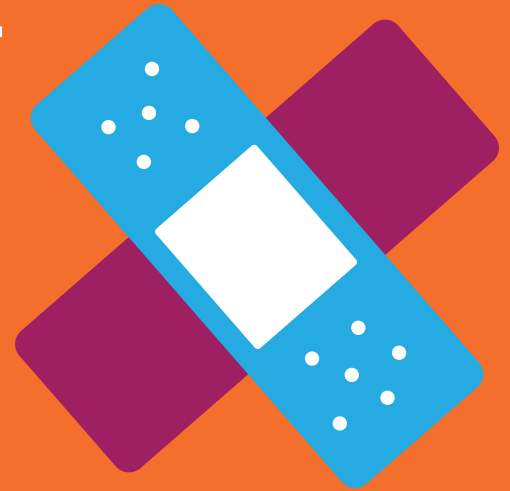
*If you are insured:* **At your health care provider or pharmacy.**

### Who should get vaccinated against hepatitis A?

- People who use injection or non-injection illegal drugs
- People currently homeless or in transient living
- Men who have sex with men
- People incarcerated in correctional facilities
- People who work with the higher risk groups listed above, such as health care providers and first responders
- People who are in close contact, care for, or live with someone who has the hepatitis A virus
- People with underlying liver disease or clotting factor disorders
- People who prepare food for others, such as food service employees and restaurant workers

### What is hepatitis A?

Hepatitis A is a virus that affects the liver, causing yellowing of the eyes and skin, nausea and stomach ache.

*Frequent handwashing can also prevent the spread of hepatitis A!*
