**Community Walk Features Unveiling of Public Art and Depot Trail Rededication Ceremony—
Free Water Bottle to All Walkers; Free T-Shirt While Supplies Last**

WHAT: The second of three community walks, sponsored by Pick Up the Pace, Saline! (PUPS). Walkers will receive a free t-shirt while supplies last. All walkers will receive a free water bottle from Temple Fitness Solutions.

WHEN: **Saturday, July 28th at 9:00 a.m.** The third (and remaining) community walk will be held on Saturday, August 25. Additional details are available on the PUPS website.

WHERE: Saline Farmers' Market parking lot (City Parking Lot #4, south on S. Ann Arbor Street, next to Little Caesars Pizza). Participants will walk to the Depot Trail and back, a distance of approximately 2 miles roundtrip. The walk should last 45-60 minutes. A short ceremony to unveil new public art and to rededicate the Depot Trail will be held. The ¼-mile Depot Trail is wheelchair-accessible.
