### NEW 2010-2011 School Immunization Rules

Starting for school year 2010-2011 the following requirements will be in effect.

Please contact your child's health care provider or Washtenaw County Public Health Dept.

**Required for: All children entering kindergarten  
All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students  
All children changing school districts**

- Two doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or history of chickenpox disease

**Required for: All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students 11 years of age  
All those 11-18 years of age who are changing school districts**

- One dose of meningococcal (MCV4 or MPSV4) vaccine
- One dose of tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccine (if 5 years have passed since last dose of tetanus/diphtheria vaccine-DTaP, Td or DT)

Vaccines also recommended by CDC for this age are:

- Three doses of Human Papillomavirus Vaccine (HPV) is recommended for girls. (HPV may also be given to boys).
- Two doses of Hepatitis A vaccine (hep A)
- One dose of Influenza vaccine (yearly).
