

Diabetic Supplies, Formulary Medications and Disease Management Resources

Brand names (in parentheses) are listed for reference. If available, only the generic product is covered. Please check the [WHP Plan A and B Drug Formulary](#) for a complete listing of dosages and medications. Items with a * are not covered by the WHP B formulary but are available at the low-cost pharmacy programs, they are covered for Plan A members. If more than the maximum quantity limit is needed, providers must contact the WHP Nurse Coordinator.

Diabetes Medications

Oral Diabetic Medications

- glipizide (Glucotrol)*
- glyburide (Micronase)*
- glucagon emergency kit **QL 1 kit/rx**
- metformin (Glucophage)*

Insulins - vials only; **QL 3/month**

- Humalog 100 U/ml
- Humalog Mix 75/25
- Humulin 50/50 and 70/30
- Humulin L, N, R 100 U/ml
- Lantus 100 U/ml
- Novolin 70/30
- Novolin N 100 U/ml
- Novolog 100 U/ml

Syringes

- B-D insulin syringes (.5cc/1 cc)

Please note that prescriptions for insulin and syringes must be filled at the same time in order to be covered by the WHP.

Supplies for Covered Glucometers

- *Glucometers:* Ascensia Breeze2, Ascensia Contour
- *Lancets:* Ascensia Microlet
- *Test strips:* Ascensia Breeze2, Ascensia Contour; **QL 100/month**

Please note that prescriptions for test strips and lancets must be filled at the same time in order to be covered by the WHP.

Formulary medications for conditions that may co-occur with or be exacerbated by diabetes

Angiotensin-Converting Enzyme (ACE) Inhibitors

- captopril (Capoten)*
- enalapril maleate (Vasotec)*
- lisinopril (Zestril)*
- lisinopril/hctz (Zestoretic)*

Statins

- lovastatin (Mevacor)
- simvastatin (Zocor)
