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### WHAT SHOULD I BRING TO MY WHP ENROLLMENT INTERVIEW?

Please bring with you:

- PROOF** that you live in Washtenaw County.
- PROOF** of ALL household Income.
  - Your child's or children's (green) MI-Health cards are proof that you are income eligible.
- OR-** bring the following:
  - Paycheck stubs — last 30 days
  - Unemployment benefits
  - Child Support information
  - Information about all other income
- ALL** medical/health insurance cards for each household member who has coverage.
- Denial letter or statement that shows end date of coverage for expired health insurance.
- Information about the cost of any health insurance you are eligible to purchase through your job.
- Information about assets worth more than \$5,000 other than your house & car.

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## WHP COVERAGE

### WHAT IS WASHTENAW HEALTH PLAN?

Washtenaw Health Plan (WHP) is a community sponsored program that helps uninsured people get medically necessary health care services.

### WHAT DOES WASHTENAW HEALTH PLAN COVER?

Washtenaw Health Plan covers medically necessary health care services including:

- Doctor/Clinic Visits
- Outpatient lab and X-ray tests
- Prescriptions from pharmacies if on the list of covered drugs
- Limited mental health services
- Hospitalization at University of Michigan Hospital or St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Washtenaw County
- ER visits for true emergencies

## WHP ELIGIBILITY

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR WASHTENAW HEALTH PLAN?

To be eligible for WHP, you must:

- Live in Washtenaw County & plan to stay for at least one year
- Not have access to other health insurance and/or coverage
- Not have liquid assets over \$5,000

### HOW MUCH INCOME IS ALLOWED?

Washtenaw Health Plan income limits are based on family size. Use this chart to see if your income is within the limits. (2008)
