

Integrated Health Program Survey

By completing this registry survey you will be part of a national registry on integrated health. This National Registry of Integrated Health Care sites is the first of several steps that the National Council for Community Behavioral Health and a dozen Foundations from across the country are taking to link people doing similar work together. The registry will gather information from integrated health sites from across the U.S. in order to gather baseline information on what is being done in the field. The information will be entered into a database that will be maintained by the Washtenaw Community Health Organization (WCHO). The only information that will be publically accessible is the information from Section 1 (general/identifying information). Anyone completing the registry will be able to search the register for "programs just like them" that they can contact for information. For example, a rural program with certain characteristics can connect with another rural organization with the same characteristics to ask a question. The rest of the information will be used to generate a de-identified grid of types and characteristics of integrated programs from across the country. As a result of registering your agency you will be eligible to participate in learning communities and/or research studies on integrated health care.
