

Lake Management/Improvement Projects

Major Steps:

1. Property owners meet to determine desire for project/Informational meeting with Washtenaw County Division of Public Works.
2. Property owners request Township(s) to move to approve the project through Washtenaw County Board of Public Works (BPW).
3. Township(s) passes an Initiating Resolution requesting assistance from County BPW.
4. BPW passes resolution to proceed with the project.
5. County Board of Commissioners passes a resolution accepting the project and directing Board of Public Works to proceed with project.
6. Lake Management/Improvement Plan is developed:
 - *Goals/Objectives*
 - *Existing Conditions*
 - *Strategies (Short-term & Long-term)*
 - *Monitoring*
 - *Estimated Project Costs*
 - *MDEQ Permits*
7. Special Assessment District Identified:
 - *Benefiting Properties*
 - *Duration of Assessment (i.e. 3 years, 5 years, etc.)*
8. BPW tentatively designates the Special Assessment District and sets the date for the first public hearing.
9. BPW holds first public hearing.
10. If BPW desires to proceed with project it shall approve another resolution stating its desire to continue and set the date for the second public hearing.
11. BPW confirms the Special Assessment Roll.
12. Bid documents developed.
13. Bids on the project are received.
14. BPW approves Bids.
15. Work begins.
