

General Information.

Dog licenses are sold in accordance to the provisions of the Dog Law of 1919 as amended. State law requires that "on or before March 1 of each year, the owner of a dog shall apply for a dog license for each dog owned or kept."

Licenses are sold in Washtenaw County on a year-round basis with the expiration of the license on the last day of the year. All dogs over four months of age must be vaccinated against rabies. The vaccinations must remain current in order for owners to obtain an annual license. You can buy an annual license beginning December 1 for the following year.

Complete the application and enclose a copy of your dog's current rabies certificate. Include your check or credit card information and mail to:

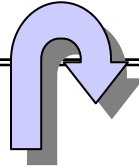

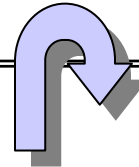

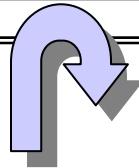
